Deterra Drug Deactivation System

This system requires that all medications are removed from all of their packaging before entering the pouch.

- 1- Tear open pouch (do not remove the inner pods)
- 2- Put in medications (i.e. pills, liquids, and patches)
 - Up to a maximum of 90 pills, 12 patches, or 12 ounces of liquids

ETERR

- Controlled substances are the top priority if there is space, include other medications
- 3- Fill halfway with warm water
- 4- Wait 30 seconds to release air (some foaming might occur)
- 5- Seal tightly and shake
- 6- Put pouch in the trash

The pouch contains a material that reacts with the medications once water is added, breaking them down and destroying them. The pouches are made from plant-based, non-toxic materials, and the medications are destroyed so they can no longer enter the environment.



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
